OPTIONAL: SUMMARY

- Identify the main character(s) and anything important about them.
- Introduce the conflict.
- Make the reader ask a question.

Example:

When Frodo Baggins inherits a golden ring from his uncle, he little realizes that is the most dangerous weapon of Middle Earth. Can Frodo resist the power of the Ring and find the strength to destroy it forever?

OVERVIEW

Summarize your overall feelings about the book in two to five sentences.

Example:

I really enjoyed LOTR because of its detailed world-building, its strong characters, and its intense action. While some of the “flowery” passages dragged for me, I would consider this book to be a must-read for any lover of epic fantasy.

CONS

Here are some ways to start your discussion:

- I felt that the story was weak in the area of...
- The story would have been better for me if...
- I would have enjoyed the story more if...
- I was disappointed/concerned by...

POTENTIALLY OFFENSIVE CONTENT

Give an objective heads up to readers about any of the following content:

- Sex
- Violence
- Swear words

PROS

QUOTE

- Pick a memorable or favorite quote from the book.
- Make sure that you remove any spoilers.
